To all Soccer referees:

The SJSL is in final preparation for our spring season. The referees in our group provide a vital service for 9000 plus youth to participate in the sport we all love. As a fellow colleague and sitting president of SJSL Executive Board along with Chuck Snyder, also a fellow colleague and sitting board member, we have put together a bullet point review of rules of play in the SJSL. We provide these to help you have a positive experience this season. If at any time, Chuck or I are available to you to answer questions and review concerns you may have with any of our members.

Administrative procedures:

- Continue checking and holding passes until match is complete.
- Match results: Preferred procedure to report match is using the QR reader at bottom or scan and email to appropriate person listed on report, or snail mail. Please remember to complete the ref info needed; names ref, AR1 , AR2. NOTE: Please do not take pictures with phones and send. The data base does not accept on our end because the file is too large. Thanks.
- GDR's: Both teams must provide before the match their GDR (Game Day Roster). All information must have been electronically entered. Nothing hand written is permitted. **The only hand-written exception is the change in uniform number.** If a player is not participating, you must cross off the name and pass number. **This is required by NJYS and the league for insurance reasons.
- **Guest Players:** a minor change will be implemented this spring. There will be a guest player addendum sheet that may be used by any team. They are required to produce before the match when you check-in players. This may be hand written but must be complete. If at any time not completed, players may not play. **NO Exception.** Please turn this in with your GDR. These you will need to scan and email or snail mail.
- **It is important that GDR's are submitted by the day after the match.** Please do not save and send in later in season. Also, ALL GDR's must be sent in even if nothing out of the ordinary occurs. We are required by law to maintain these for 2 years in the event of insurance inquires.

Rules of play: SJSL Modifications

- **Small sided.** A separate attachment will review the rules of play for 7v7 and 9v9 play. It especially explains the rules dealing with the build out line. Important to review. These are the ONLY version to be used in SJSL Play.
- **Div 1 games:** U17 and older- **40 min halves**
- SJSL rules for subbing have NOT changed. Subs MUST be at halfway line before request to sub. Important we all follow this procedure. Throw ins. After goals. Goal kicks. Start of half. **NO subs on corners or dead-ball fouls on field!!!!**
