South Jersey Soccer League General Membership Meeting Minutes

February 21, 2019

Call to Order:	Meeting called to order by Larry Young at 8:00 PM	
Cape Express:	Beach Blast presentation. This is a sand soccer tournament in Wildwood NJ. In 2008, they had 180 teams. The fee is 830.00, which includes a wristband for Morey's piers for the four-day weekend.	
Secretary Report:	The December 13, 2018 GM minutes were distributed to the General Membership via email and online for review. Motion to accept: Pennsgrove, second: Burlington Twp. Vote for approval – unanimous.	
Attendance:	All clubs attended, with the exception of: Gloucester County Union, Hamilton Elite, LAC, Millville, Pitman, Runnemede, South Harrison, Seneca.	
Treasurer's Report:	<p>Treasurer's report for January 2019 was distributed via email for review by the membership. January was a light month for expenses, which include trophies at \$1,266.00 being the next large expense. Motion to accept: Northern Burlington, second: Florence. Vote for approval – unanimous.</p> <p>Tom would like to see the following clubs after the meeting: Collingswood, Cohansey, Medford Strikers and Marlton.</p>	
Registrar's Report:	<p>Chuck mentioned the disbanding deadline was February 1st. The deadline to add/transfer players was extended from February 20th to February 28th.</p> <p>Bob/Heather reviewed adding new players in Kyck and Got Soccer. Bob reminded all reps to check their ID numbers in got soccer. A new event shows default every season and needs to be changed to US Club so the ID numbers populate on the GDRs. See further overview of the process below under New Business – Adding/Releasing Players</p>	
Rules and Compliance Report:	Tom reported we had a few suspensions carry over from fall to spring. Two players and one coach. That information will go out directly to the coaches soon.	
Old Business:	GDR's	GDR's will be ready to print 3 days prior to games. The referee names should now be printed on the GDR's.
	SJ Cup	<p>Heather thanked Voorhees, TBAA, Marlton and CHSC for hosting the cup games. She announced the dates of the semi-finals on April 13/14th and finals on May 18/19th. We are in need of volunteers to help at both of these events. We sent out the pre order form for the t-shirts and the volunteer link.</p> <p>Chuck mentioned that cup rosters are a separate event and all of those rosters are locked.</p> <p>Heather pointed out that all rosters were locked/frozen and printed in October and there will be a check in process before games.</p> <p>Heather also reminded everyone that there is no guest playing for cup games.</p> <p>Bob pointed out some cup roster situations. For example, if a player leaves a team in the fall to play for a different league in the spring and the SJ card is still valid, they can still play in the semi-finals/final games. If a player leaves one club in the SJ league to</p>

		play for another club, the card is invalid and they cannot play with the original club in the cup game. If that player's new team is playing in the semifinal/final games he cannot play with that team either since rosters are locked.
	Coaching Courses	We have 63 new coaches for the spring season between the two leagues. The level 2 course will be rolled out in April/May. Bob mentioned that any club who is hosting this course will be asked to provide teams/players to help with the course.
	Guest Players	Scott mentioned the guest player process is still the same with the deadline being Friday night. One small change in the policy is there will not be any handwritten players on the GDRs. The guest player form must be handed in with the GDRs on game day. Scott reminded all to make sure the name and the pass number is typed in correctly when sending a guest player request. Scott will be watching for any flight disparity with girls' guest playing. Larry pointed out that guest players are still in a review process.
	5 Year Planning Committee	We have two clubs (Washington Twp and Burlington Twp) along with a few board members on this committee. Scott would like to get more clubs to join. The first meeting is slated for next Wednesday February 27 th in Voorhees.
New Business:	New Board Members	Larry welcomed Heather Talarico as Recording Secretary and Keith Rambo as Information Officer.
	Schedules	Our target date for schedules to be released is the beginning of March. We are scheduled to open the season on March 10th
	Adding/Releasing Players – Kyck & Got Soccer	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Use Kyck play login for player info, complete mandatory fields. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cards-request cards-player will be listed as viewable if submitted correctly Create a SJ roster in US Club for league to see players Enter 7-digit pass ID into GotSoccer ID numbers remain with the player, the pass must reflect the club and league appropriately MUST be US Club pass number to allow players to participate in league events. Open every roster and check ID numbers, log in as team, team details, change box to “US Club” for each new season to ensure proper pass numbers are listed. To Remove a player: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go to team, player, view all players, click "x" to remove Same Club, release is not necessary Required for a player moving to a new club (before player can be added to a new club) Upon requesting cards, a notice will be shown if a player is carded elsewhere

3. GotSoccer roster process:

- Unlock roster
- Register new player
- For instructions, go to SJSL website– coaches resources tab, add/drop/release steps and procedures
- Submission is reviewed for correct ages, roster limits, # of transfers, etc.
- Players must be released from the Spring roster if going to another team
- If players are “removed” from GotSoccer, they must be re-added prior to them being on an active roster
- Add/Drop request form on SJSL website (top right section)
- Feb 28th deadline to transfer players (originally 2/20)
- Disband deadline is Feb 1st to allow players to transfer without requiring the 3 game sit requirement
